

**OCCUPATION: MARINE ENVIRONMENT INTERPRETER (EQUIVALENT TO ANZSCO SKILL LEVEL 1)**

**Position Description:** The role of the Marine Environment Interpreter is to promote science in tourism through high quality interpretation of both the marine environment and associated research. The role may focus on one or more areas of marine science, such as high-quality interpretation for tourists on the World Heritage Great Barrier Reef, Coral Reef Monitoring, Reef Health Management and Research, or similar marine fields such as in connection with whale migration or other marine science.

**Main Duties and Tasks (may include but not limited to):**

- conducting marine biology and marine environmental presentations
- conducting guided snorkelling and/or diving tours that include marine interpretation
- conducting fish-feeding presentations with associated educational interpretation
- conducting climate-change presentations in line with core values and messages
- train and mentor other general snorkel and diving guides, including Indigenous Reef Education Rangers, in marine biology interpretation, reef health management and research
- support research bodies (such as the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority - GBRMPA) with monitoring and research of the marine environment, through marine life and water sampling, data collection, and using marine science technology
- conduct surveys and reporting on the marine environment as required, to augment marine environmental management and research by research bodies (such as GBRMPA).
